## **SCHEDULE OF CLASSES FOR SHEEP AND GOAT SECTION**

### **Conditions for entry**

1. In all cases, breed must be stated in the entry form e.g, Corriedale, Dorper, Red Maasai, Toggenburg, Alpine, Cross e.t.c
2. A group or a pen will be considered as one entry for judging and entry fees.
3. Exhibits must arrive at the show grounds on 19<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> July, ready for Judging on 21<sup>st</sup> July at 8.00 a.m.
4. Unless otherwise instructed (e.g. during livestock parade and judging) all exhibits must remain in their stables as allocated by the stabling steward.
5. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to forward their exhibits to the judging rings and to parade as and when instructed by the breed steward who has authority from the show management.
6. The show committee requests the exhibitors to keep the stables and the exhibits tidy throughout the duration of the show. Likewise, the handlers and attendants are expected to be neat in their attire, courteous to the animals, the show officials, the show goers and the public at large.

### **SHEEP CLASSES – (SECTION A)**

1. Ram lamb, milk teeth only, pedigree or non- pedigree.
2. Ram, two teeth and over, pedigree or non-pedigree
3. Ewe lamb, milk teeth only pedigree or non-pedigree.
4. Ewe two teeth and over, pedigree or non-pedigree
5. Group of three ewes any age
6. Group of two ewes and one ram two teeth and over pedigree or non-pedigree.
7. Champion Ram, no entry required, to be selected from first and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 1 and 2.
8. Champion Ewe. No entry required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 3 and 4 above

### **SHEEP – FAT STOCK (SECTION B)**

9. Pen of three lambs any breed. Milk teeth only and ready for slaughter. Total live weight of pen (88 – 130 kgs). Breed to be stated.
10. Pen of three grade A mutton, ewes or wethers two teeth only. Total weight of pen (131 – 170) kgs. Breed to be stated.

11. Pen of three fat ewes or wethers, two teeth and over, minimum live weight of pen 150 kg. Breed to be stated.
12. Pen of red Maasai or any other indigenous sheep including the Dorper and Dorper crosses. No weight limit of pen.
13. Champion Sheep Fat Stock. No entry required to be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 9,10,11 and 12.
14. Exhibitors gaining the most points in the sheep and sheep fat stock classes. No entry required. Points to be awarded as follows:-

1 <sup>st</sup> - 4	3 <sup>rd</sup> - 2	Champion 6
2 <sup>nd</sup> - 3	4 <sup>th</sup> - 1	Reserve Champion 5

### **DAIRY GOAT CLASSES (SECTION C)**

15. Male, milk teeth only
16. Male two teeth and over. Dam and sire to be stated.
17. Female, milk teeth only. Date of birth to be stated
18. Female, two teeth and over dry. If in kid date of service to be declared.
19. Female, two teeth and over in milk. Date of last kidding to be declared.
20. Group of 2 females, and one male, milk teeth only.
21. Group of two females and one male, four tooth and over.
22. Champion and Reserve Champion Male. No entry required, to be selected from first and second prize winners in classes 15 and 16
23. Champion and Reserve Champion Female. No entry required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 17, and 18.

### **INTERBREED DAIRY GOATS (SECTION D)**

24. Supreme Champion Dairy Nanny of the show. No entry required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize winners in classes 22 and 23 of section C
25. Supreme Champion and Reserve Champion Billy of the show. No entry required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners of class 22 of section C.

### **CROSS BRED DAIRY GOATS (SECTION E)**

26. Male, milk teeth only. Date of birth to be declared.
27. Male two teeth and over.
28. Female, milk teeth only. Date of birth to be declared.
29. Female, two teeth and over dry. Date of last service to be declared.
30. Female two teeth and over and in milk. Date of last kidding to be stated.
31. Group of one male two teeth and over with two off springs of any age or sex.
32. Champion and Reserve Champion Female. No entry required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 28,29 & 30.

33. Champion and Reserve Champion Grade Male. No entry required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 26 and 27.

### **GOATS – FAT STOCK (SECTION F)**

34. Pen of three male any breed, milk teeth only ready for slaughter.  
35. Pen of three, males (castrates) ready for slaughter, two tooth and over.  
36. Pen of 3, females two tooth and over, ready for slaughter.

### **MEAT GOAT CLASSES (SECTION G)**

37. Male, milk teeth only. Date of birth to be declared.  
38. Male, two teeth and over.  
39. Female, milk teeth only. Date of birth to be declared.  
40. Female two teeth and over in milk. Date of last service to be declared.  
41. Female, two teeth and over, dry. Date of last kidding to be declared.  
42. Pen of three, one male and two females, any age.  
43. Champion and Reserve Champion Male. No entry required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 37 and 38.  
44. Champion and Reserve Champion Female. No entry required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 39, 40 and 41.

Note – classes 37 to 41 are open only to Galla goats, small E African Goat and Boer goats. Respective breeds will be judged separately. However there will be Interbreed Championships.

### **SPECIAL CLASSES (SECTION H)**

**YOUNG STOCK AND YOUNG HANDLERS CLASS** . Entry fee: KShs. 200.00 per entry.

For Sheep – WOOL and also for Sheep – MUTTON. For Goat – MILK and Goat – MEAT.  
Class 45: Lamb, Ram, Nanny or Billy Milk teeth only, handler up to 12 years and under.  
Class 46: Lamb, Ram, Nanny or Billy Milk teeth only, handler 13 to 16 years of age.  
The Classes will be judged on a) Best Individual Handler and b) Best behavior of animal.

No entry required.

47. Exhibitor gaining the most points in the sheep classes.  
48. Exhibitor gaining the most points in the meat Goat classes.  
49. Exhibitor gaining the most points in the Dairy goat classes.

Points will be awarded as follows:- Champion 6 points, Reserve Champion 5 points, 1<sup>st</sup> Prize 4 Points, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize 3 Points, 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize 2 Points and 4<sup>th</sup> prize 1 Point.

- a) All fleeces must be properly skirted and placed down on the display rack at the wool pavilion in the main Arena.
  - b) Exhibits must be in the wool pavilion on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2016
  - c) Not more than 4 entries (exhibits) per class per exhibitor

1. Merino Ram Fleece, fine
  2. Merino Ram Fleece medium fine
  3. Merino Ram Fleece strong
  4. Merino Ewe or Wether Fleece
  5. Merino Lamb Fleece
  6. Champion and Reserve Champion Merino Fleece. No entries required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winner in classes 1,2,3,4 and 5.
  7. Corriedale Ram Fleece
  8. Corriedale Ewe or Wether Fleece
  9. Corriedale Lamb Fleece
  10. Champion and Reserve Champion Corriedale fleece. No entries required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 7,8,9 and 10.
  11. Romney Ram Fleece
  12. Romney Ewe or Wether Fleece.
  13. Romney Lamb Fleece.
  14. Champion and Reserve Champion Romney Fleece. No entries required. To be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 11, 12 and 13.

### **Veterinary regulations**

- 1) All livestock to enter the Showground, by vehicle only, through the Kibera gate, where they will be inspected by a veterinary officer. Cattle with skin diseases, foot rot or any unsightly condition will be refused entry to the showground.
- 2) Movement permits are necessary, and should comply with veterinary regulations ruling at the time. Exhibitors should contact their local veterinary, or livestock office. There will be no movement of cattle from a farm in quarantine. Adult cattle originating from farms in compulsory vaccination areas need not necessarily be re-vaccinated provided they have been vaccinated at least twice routinely.
- 3) All cattle must be sprayed on arrival at the showground.
- 4) Exhibitors must sign a certificate to the effect that to the best of his/her knowledge livestock entering the showground are not suffering from any contagious disease.
