Schedule of Classes for Jerseys

Conditions

- Closing date for entries is 31st May 2023 but it would be appreciated if entries could be submitted sooner. Entry fees 600/- per head. Young Handlers 300/-. Groups & Production free. Late entries will not be accepted. Group members & Production entrants must also be entered as individuals in their relevant inspection class.
- Full details of exhibits must be entered on entry form, including sire & dam, all birth & calving dates. All animals must be registered with KSB as at least Foundation. Copies of Registration Certificates, and for production classes copies of Official Lactation Certificates, to accompany entries.
- Ages will be calculated from the first day of the Show i.e. **3rd August 2023.** Transfers may be made between classes free of charge if an animal calves early or fails to calve on her due date.
- Committee reserves the right to inspect any cattle entered, & if necessary to limit numbers of entries. Classes may be combined or divided if entries are insufficient or too many. Lines to be left clean and tidy on departure from the showground.

Animals should be in place by 5pm on 2nd August 2023 The show will close after a final Grand Parade of Livestock on the afternoon of 5th August 2023 **NB** to exit Showground **Movement Permits & ASK Gate Passes** will be required.

Veterinary Regulations

- **Movement permits** are necessary. The regulations regarding Foot and Mouth Disease vaccination to be communicated at a later date. Lumpy Skin Disease & Anthrax vaccination are recommended but not obligatory. Exhibitors should check with their local Veterinary/Livestock Office if anything else is needed. There will be no movement of cattle from a farm in quarantine.
- Exhibitors must sign a certificate to the effect that to the best of their knowledge their cattle are not suffering from any contagious or infectious disease. All cattle must be sprayed with acaricide. Exhibitors must clear their livestock with the veterinary officer on arrival at the Showground. Any animals with skin diseases, foot rot or any unsightly condition will be refused entry.

Jersey Classes (to be judged on first & second days, 3rd & 4thth Aug 2023

1. HEIFER CALF under 12 months, born 04.08.22 or after.

2. **HEIFER** 12months & under 20 months, born 04.12.21 - 03.08.22 Service date to be stated

3. In Calf HEIFER 20 months & under 3 years born 04.08.20 - 03.12.21 Service date to be stated

4. CHAMPION HEIFER - no entry required - to be selected from 1st & 2^{nd} placed animals in heifer classes 1, 2 & 3.

5. YOUNG HANDLERS a) 12 years & under b) 13 to 16 years.
 Names & ages to be given. To handle uncalved heifers
 1st & 2nd placed to go forward to Interbreed

6. CALVED HEIFER born in 2021 or after Date of calving to be stated
7. YOUNG COW born in 2020 State dates of all calvings
8. JUNIOR COW born in 2019 State dates of all calvings
9. JUNIOR CHAMPION - no entry required - to be selected from 1st & 2nd placed animals in classes 6,7 & 8.
10. SENIOR COW born in 2018 State dates of all calvings
11. MATURE COW born in 2016 or 2017 State dates of all calvings
12. VINTAGE COW born in 2015 or before

State dates of all calvings

13. **SENIOR CHAMPION** - no entry required - to be selected from 1st & 2nd placed animals in classes 10, 11 & 12.

14. **SUPREME JERSEY CHAMPION (Heather Mills Memorial Trophy)** to be selected from Heifer, Junior and Senior Champions & Reserves

15. **THE BEST UDDER -** up to 2 animals from each herd - judge may nominate. Conformation not to count. No entry required.

Jerseys continued.

- NB Members of Progeny Groups need not be from same exhibitor
- 16. JUNIOR PROGENY 3 uncalved heifers by the same sire. Entries in name of sire
- 17. **SENIOR PROGENY** 3 cows by the same sire

Entries in name of sire

- 18. MOTHER & DAUGHTER CLASS
- 19. **GROUP OF TWO** daughters by the same sire, both of whom have attained at least a Silver Medal. *Entries in name of sire*
- 20. **EXHIBITOR'S STRING of 5** animals which in the Judge's opinion is the most even for breed conformation, type and dairy character.
- 21. STOCKMAN as for Interbreed. a) Judge to nominate after Class 19.b) to be awarded on the last day.

section a) 1^{st} & 2^{nd} to go forward to Interbreed.

PRODUCTION (to be judged on the second day, 4th August 2023)

<u>Classes 22 & 23</u> for animals calving **2nd August 2017- 1st August 2022** Lactations up to 305d. DRSK certificates to show **at least** one fat & protein test in each 100 days. *Relevant laboratory test sheets to accompany entries*. Points to be awarded -

Junior Production - 1 point for each 3.5kg fat + protein Senior Production - 1 point for each 4kg fat + protein Judge to be informed of production point spread 100 points maximum on inspection.

22. JUNIOR PRODUCTION for females under 4 years of age at calving. Junior Production Cows must have had their 1st calf at under 3 years old

- 23. SENIOR PRODUCTION for females 4 years old & over at calving.
- 24. MATRONS CLASS for cows with at least 6 normal calvings. Lactations of up to 365 days. If animals are shown in milk an interim certificate dated up to 15th May 2023 may be submitted.
 10 points for each calving with an additional 10 if in calf again (on production of veterinary certificate dated within last month)
 1 point for every 500kg milk 2 points per 50kg butterfat
 100 points for wearing qualities (especially udders & feet)
 100 points for general conformation, quality and style

Interbreed Classes (to be judged on the last day, 5th August 2023)

1. Supreme Dairy Champion Female of the Show (Brookside Cup) No entry required. Breed Society to nominate up to 3 animals, one of which must be the Champion Female of the Breed.

2. Supreme Champion Dairy Female of the Show

No entry required. Breed Society to nominate up to 3 animals (one the Female Champion) from entrants in their breed classes.

- Conditions -
- a) Animals to have calved between_2nd August 2017- 1st August 2022 (inclusive of both dates).
- b) Official DRSK certificates to be submitted by the day before judging, giving lactation figures for up to 305 days.
- c) Only records with butterfats of at least 3.3% to be considered. Certificates should show **at least** one fat test in each 100 days. *Laboratory test sheets showing fat figures and dates required.*
- d) Points to be awarded: -
 - 1 point for every 50 kg milk
 - 2 points for every 5 kg butterfat
 - 200 points maximum for each animal on inspection

3. Progeny Class (Brookside Trophy) Open to all dairy breeds.

Breed Societies to nominate teams of three animals sired by the same sire, not necessarily from same exhibitor, but which have all been shown in their relevant breed classes.

4. Young Handlers Competition Open to all dairy & beef breeds, sheep and goats. For the 1st & 2nd placed from each breed.
Names & ages of all entrants to be given. To be held in 2 sections (a) handlers 12 years and under. b) handlers aged 13 to 16 years. *To handle uncalved heifers, any age.*

5. Stockman's Competition. No entries required. Open to all Cattle Stockmen and Exhibitors with animals forward. Competition to be in two parts:a) Best Individual Handler. 1st & 2nd placed from each breed.
Judge's nomination taking into consideration enthusiasm & turnout
b) Best maintained Cattle Lines, to be judged on last day of the Show at 9am, by Breed Society's appointed panel. Criteria to include condition of cattle plus cleanliness of cattle line & environment.

6. **Team of Seven Animals of any one Dairy Breed** No entry required. Dairy Breed Societies to nominate teams of seven animals.
