SCHEDULE OF CLASSES FOR SHEEP AND GOATS SECTION

Conditions for Entry

- 1. In all cases, the breed must be stated in the entry form
- 2. All animals must be inspected by a breed inspector accredited by respective breed society/association or Kenya Livestock Breeders Association (KLBA/KSB)
- 3. A group or a pen will be considered as one entry
- 4. Exhibits must arrive at the showground on 1st or 2nd August 2023, ready for judging on 3rd August 2023, starting at 8:00 am.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to present their exhibits to the prescribed judging rings and to parade as and when instructed by the steward who has authority from the show management.
- 6. Exhibits must be adequately prepared and trained prior to coming for the show.
- 7. Exhibitors are required to keep the stables and exhibits tidy throughout the show period.
- 8. All handlers and attendants are expected to be presentable in their attire, courteous to the animals, show officials, show goers and the public at large.

SECTION A. SHEEP CLASSES

- 1. Ram lamb milk teeth
- 2. Ram 2 teeth and under 4 teeth
- 3. Ram 4 teeth and over
- 4. Ewe lamb milk teeth
- 5. Ewe 2 teeth and under 4 teeth
- 6. Ewe 4 teeth and over
- 7. Group of 3 ewes any age
- 8. Group of 2 ewes and 1 ram 2 teeth and over
- 9. Champion ram (No entry required, to be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 2 and 3 above). **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book**.
- 10. Champion ewe (No entry required, to be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 5 and 6 above). **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book**.

SECTION B. SHEEP FAT STOCK

Class:

- 11. Pen of 3 lambs, any breed. Milk teeth and ready for slaughter. Total live weight of pen (88-130 Kgs). Breed to be stated.
- 12. Pen of 3 grade 'A' mutton, ewes or wethers, 2 teeth only. Total weight of pen (131-170 Kgs). Breed to be stated.
- 13. Pen of 3 fat ewes or wethers, 2 teeth and over. Minimum live weight of pen (150 Kgs). Breed to be stated.
- 14. Pen of Red Maasai sheep or Dorper sheep or their crosses. No weight limit of pen.
- 15. Champion sheep fat stock. No entry required, to be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 11, 12, 13 and 14 above.
- 16. Exhibitor gaining the most points in the sheep and sheep fat stock classes. No entry required.

Points to be awarded as follows:

1st prize 4 points, 2nd prize 3 points, 3rd prize 2 points, 4th prize 1 point Champion prize 6 points, Reserve Champion prize 5 points

SECTION C. DAIRY GOATS

- 17. Male milk teeth
- 18. Male 2 teeth and under 4 teeth
- 19. Male 4 teeth and over
- 20. Female milk teeth
- 21. Female 2 teeth and over, DRY.
- 22. Female 2 teeth and over, LACTATING.
- 23. Group of 2 females and 1 male, milk teeth
- 24. Group of 2 females and 1 male, 4 teeth and over.
- 25. Champion male. No entry required, to be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 18 and 19 above. **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book.**
- 26. Champion female. No entry required, to be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 20, 21, and 22 above. **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book.**

SECTION D. INTER-BREED DAIRY GOATS

Class:

- 27. Supreme Champion Dairy Nanny of the show. No entry required. To be selected from champion and reserve champion prize winners in class 26 above. **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book.**
- 28. Supreme Champion Dairy Billy of the show. No entry required. To be selected from champions and reserve champions in class 25 above. **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book.**

SECTION E. GOATS FAT STOCK

Class:

- 29. Pen of 3 males any breed, milk teeth and ready for slaughter
- 30. Pen of 3 males (castrates) ready for slaughter 2 teeth and over.
- 31. Pen of 3 females 2 teeth and over, ready for slaughter.

SECTION F. MEAT GOAT

- 32. Male milk teeth
- 33. Male 2 teeth and under 4 teeth.
- 34. Male 4 teeth and over
- 35. Female milk teeth
- 36. Female 2 teeth and under 4 teeth
- 37. Female 4 teeth and over
- 38. Pen of 3; 1 male and 2 females, any age.
- 39. Champion male. No entry required, to be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 33 and 34 above. **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book**.
- 40. Champion female. No entry required, to be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 36 and 37 above. **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book.**

SECTION G. INTER-BREED MEAT GOAT

Class:

- 41. Supreme champion meat Nanny of the show. No entry required, to be selected from the champion and reserve champion in class 40 above. **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book**.
- 42. Supreme champion meat Billy of the show. No entry requires, to be selected from the champion and reserve champion in class 39 above. **Must be registered with Kenya Stud Book.**

SECTION H. YOUNG STOCK AND YOUNG HANDLERS

(Entry fee; Ksh. 200/- per entry. Class covers both sheep and goat entries) Class:

- 43. Lamb, Ram, Nanny or Billy. Milk teeth. Handler, under 12 years of age.
- 44. Lamb, Ram, Nanny, or Billy. Milk teeth. Handler, 13 to 16 years of age.

The class will be judged on; a). Best individual handler

b). Best behaviour of animal

No entries required.

Class:

- 45. Exhibitor gaining the most points in dairy goat classes.
- 46. Exhibitor gaining the most points in meat goat and fat stock classes.

Points to be awarded as follows:

1st prize 4 points, 2nd prize 3 points, 3rd prize 2 points, 4th prize 1 point, Champion 6 points, Reserve Champion 5 points

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES FOR FLEECE

Note:

- a). All fleeces must be properly skirted and placed down on the display rack at the wool pavilion.
- b). Exhibits must be in the wool pavilion on 2nd August 2023.
- c). Not more than 4 entries (exhibits) per class per exhibitor.

- 1. Merino Ram fleece, fine
- 2. Merino Ram fleece, medium fine
- 3. Merino Ram fleece, strong
- 4. Merino Ewe or wether fleece
- 5. Merino lamb fleece
- 6. Champion and Reserve Champion Merino fleece. No entries required. To be selected from 1st and 2nd price winners in class 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 above.
- 7. Corriedale Ram fleece
- 8. Corriedale Ewe or wether fleece
- 9. Corriedale lamb fleece
- 10. Champion and Reserve champion Corriedale fleece. No entry required. To be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in class 7, 8, and 9 above.
- 11. Romney Ram fleece
- 12. Romney Ewe or wether fleece
- 13. Romney lamb fleece
- 14. Champion and reserve Champion Romney fleece. No entry required. To be selected from 1st and 2nd prize winners in class 11, 12 and 13 above.

Veterinary Regulations

- 1. All livestock to enter the Showground by vehicle only, through the Kibera Gate, where they will be inspected by veterinary officer. Cattle with skin diseases, foot rot or any unsightly condition will be refused entry to the Showground.
- 2. Movement permits are necessary and should comply with regulations ruling at that time. Exhibitors should contact their local veterinary or livestock office. There will be no movement of cattle from a farm in quarantine. Adult cattle originating from farms in compulsory vaccination areas need not necessarily be re-vaccinated provided they have been vaccinated at least twice routinely.
- 3. All cattle must be sprayed on arrival at the ground.
- 4. Exhibitors must sign a certificate to the effect that to the best of his/her knowledge livestock entering the showground are not suffering from any contagious disease.

GUIDELINES FOR LIVESTOCK TO BE AUCTIONED DURING LBS&S 2023

Objectives of the livestock auction: -

- Afford breeders opportunity to sell quality livestock at premium prices
- > Afford opportunity to interested farmers purchase quality livestock
- Advertisement opportunity for the Show and the Breeders
- > Earn revenue for the LBST and Breed Societies

Guidelines

- Livestock eligible for auction will include Dairy (females only), dual purpose (males and females) & beef cattle, sheep & goats (males and females)
- Breeder should be a paid-up member of respective Breed Society
- Livestock to be auctioned must be registered at pedigree purebred or appendix
- > The Livestock should be entered in respective classes and be judged
- ➤ Livestock to be auctioned must meet all veterinary requirements prior to being transported to showground
- > Productivity of the livestock to be auctioned must be above herd / flock average in the traits of economic value
- ➤ Breeders will be required to fill a designated form for each livestock for sale and submit together with show entries
- ➤ Auction entry fees shall be Ksh1,000 for cattle and Ksh 500 for small stock
- 3% and 3% of each sale proceeds will be remitted to the Livestock Breeders Show Trust and the Auctioneer (Breeder/Farmer to receive 94% of the sale proceeds)
- ➤ Sale proceeds of champions shall remit 10% to the Livestock Breeders Show Trust, 3% to the auctioneer (Breeder/Farmer to receive 87% of the sale proceeds)
- > All sales of livestock shall be done through the auction

- > Breeder will be allowed to set minimum price and if not achieved can return unsold livestock home.
- > Auctioned livestock shall be allowed to leave the showground only after the show

TRANSPORT REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES FOR LIVESTOCK BREEDERS SHOW 2023

RAILAGE is not applicable this year.

Road Transport subsidy is given in the attached schedule – rates are per animal per km basis for the three categories.

Note that subsidy is paid for one way and shall not be claimed to transport feed. See other notes below;

- 1. Maximum subsidy shall be claimed for **Cattle** within Kenyan borders to any one exhibitor is **KES. 90,000.00** per lorry load.
- 2. Maximum subsidy shall be claimed for **Small Stock** within Kenyan borders to any one exhibitor is **KES. 60,000.00** per lorry load.
- 3. Maximum subsidy shall be claimed for **Other Stock** within Kenyan borders to any one exhibitor is **KES. 30,000.00** per lorry load.
- 4. Minimum subsidy shall be claimed for **Cattle** within Kenyan borders to any one exhibitor is **KES. 15,000.00** per lorry load.
- 5. Minimum subsidy shall be claimed for **Small Stock** within Kenyan borders to any one exhibitor is **KES. 10,000.00** per lorry load.
- 6. Minimum subsidy shall be claimed for **Other Stock** within Kenyan borders to any one exhibitor is **KES. 5,000.00** per lorry load.
- 7. Proof of tonnage of all vehicles used to transport exhibits and number of animals transported is necessary to attach to a claim form.
- 8. Breed Society Chairman or their representative are required to provide the Treasurer's Office with exact mileage to ASK from where the animals are transported from.
- 9. Exhibitors may obtain transport refund claim forms from their Breed Society representative or the Treasurer's Office on arrival at the Show Ground.

- 10. Please make sure that your claim form is approved by the Breed Society Chairman and all relevant support documents attached before approaching the Treasurer's office for payment.
- 11. Please note that transport reimbursement applied above is not full compensation of actual cost of transport but **a subsidy** towards cost incurred in ferrying the animals to the Show.
- 12. Only one transport subsidy shall be paid for shared transport which the same should be shared between the exhibitors.

We look forward to your cooperation in this regard.
